Cost \$110 plus tax for 3 or \$99 plus tax for 2. \$50 non-refundable deposit required with balance due by March 21st. Food expenses will be shared by members attending. Cabins have kitchens.

Fish the first class Bighorn River via boat or wading. The Brown Palace a cabin that can accommodate 7 comfortably has been reserved. Cost is \$140 per night for 4 people with an additional \$10 added for each additional person. \$50 non-refundable deposit required from those wishing to stay in the cabin. Balance due by April 1st. RV and camping spaces are also available. Food expenses will be shared by members attending or members may eat at local restaurant.

Pike and trout fishing, make your choice. Members will camp in Stagecoach State Park at the Harding Spur Campground. Camp sites #67, 69, 72 and 74 are the best sites (within walking distance to the water). Campsites \$16 per day and sites w/electrical hookups (other area of park) are \$20 per day. Excellent belly boat water or you can walk the shores to spot fish. Yampa River is less than a few miles away both below the dam or above the reservoir. Doug will be hosting chili dinner Saturday night.

Fishing will be a combination of float trips and wade fishing on the North Platte from Treasure Island to the Picks Bridge area below Saratoga. We will be at base camp each night. Food expenses will be shared. No electrical hookups, but there is room for RVs and trailers and of course tents. An area the club visited several years ago with great success.

Car Camp – Hike In

Mike will be scouting out this area and making a decision as to where base camp will be set up. Mainly browns and rainbows with a few cutthroats will make for great action.

August 17th to 20th **Flat Tops Wilderness – Derby Creek** Dave Townsend 303-973-0549
Back Pack – Flat Tops area

A short 3 mile hike with less than a 400 foot gain in elevation to base camp. \$20 deposit to cover gas expenses. Sign up cut-off date July 18th. Food/cooking logistics will be discussed at later date. The area has some very diverse fishing waters from small streams to meandering lazy creeks, beaver ponds and high mountain lakes.

September 8th to 15th **West Yellowstone – Madison River** Geoff Bostic 303-619-7214

Staying at the Montana Spirit Lodge situated on 2 miles of the Madison. Geoff says this part of the river sees few fishermen because there are no locations above the lodge where guides can put in their boats. Lodge has room for 12 HPD members. \$150 non-refundable deposit will be required. Balance will be due by June 20th. Total lodging cost about \$350 per person. Units have full cooking facilities allowing members to share meal expenses and cooking duties.

October 5th to 7th **Upper Gunnison River** Geoff Bostic 303-619-7214

The fall Kokanee salmon run brings loads of hard fighting sockeye salmon up the Gunnison River from Blue Mesa Reservoir as they run all the way to the Roaring Judy fish hatchery on the East River. Following the salmon are big trout feeding on the eggs. The Taylor River and the East meet near Almont where HPD members will be staying. A \$50.00 non-refundable deposit required for lodging. Final sign up and balance due by August 15th club meeting.

What Else? The club will be hosting additional day trips throughout the year and there will be the annual July picnic. Keep June 16th open as well as volunteers are needed for Kid's Day.
