

## PIKE FISHING TRIP

Stagecoach State Park – June 1, 2, & 3<sup>rd</sup>.

This trip is a belly boat, pontoon or small boat trip. The best campsites that are near the water are in Harding Spur Campground, site #67, 69, 72 & 74. Trip captain will be in site #72. Please call and make your own reservations for the Harding Spur Campground in Stagecoach State Park (303-470-1144) . These campsites have no electric hook-up. There are other electric campsites in the State Park. The State Park does have pay showers at the Marina. There are also a number of motels in Steamboat Springs which is 12 miles north of the State Park.

Stagecoach State Park is south of Steamboat Springs on Highway 131. You can go over Rabbit Ears Pass and at the bottom take a left on Highway 131 towards Yampa or turn left just north of Wolford Reservoir and go over Gore Pass on Highway 134 go thru Yampa and Oak Creek to the State Park

Each vehicle must have a Colorado State Parks pass or a current Colorado State Parks day pass which can be purchased at the entrance to the State Park. Reservation fee is \$10.00 per campsite. One person must be the primary contact for that campsite. State reservation requires that person's name, phone # and address for each campsite being reserved. Campsite without electric is \$16.00 per day and with electric hook-up is \$20.00 per day. Life jackets are required when fishing in a State Park. Members should coordinate with each other to share a campsite and share expenses on the reservations and food, if desired. Maximum 6 people per site – maximum 2 vehicles per site. One motorhome or camper plus one or two tents per site.

We will get have a get-together on Saturday night the 2<sup>nd</sup> at campsite #72 at 7:30. Chili will be provided by the trip captain, see sign up sheet for side dishes prior to this trip. Bring your own place setting and drinks.
